Example:

Physical Development

Goal: Increase Gross Motor Skills

Next Step: Development of upper body strength

Activity: Laundry Basket Scooters

Description: On a carpeted area free from obstruction, the child will push a weighted laundry basket (fill with laundry or soft toys) across carpeted area

Next Step: Demonstrates increased throwing skill

Activity: Sock Toss

Description: Place a large hoola hoop on the ground . Give child several pairs of rolled socks to throw into the center of the hoop.
